LOS ANGELES HONORS THE VICTIMS OF CHERNOBYL

**Local & international readings reveal
how people still have health problems 23 years later**

Voices From Chornobyl is a play that explores how the Chornobyl disaster affected the people living in the area, including the long-term mental and physical effects of radiation.

The Anniversary Readings kick off this April. Many readings around Los Angeles and worldwide expose the ongoing effects of the Chornobyl disaster through the universal language of theater, aiming to motivate the play's audience to help the charities that give aid to children in Belarus.

During the month of April, the rights to perform the play **Voices From Chornobyl** by Cindy Marie Jenkins are free to anyone who donates at least 75% of their proceeds to a Chornobyl Charity.

The **Goal** of the VFC Anniversary Readings is not only to raise awareness, but also to present an ongoing platform around the world to support those still affected by the Chornobyl disaster. By utilizing the templates already in place by V-Day and Earth Day, the VFC Anniversary Readings will serve as the doorway for people who do not know how an accident in 1986 can still have health effects today. The Anniversary Readings will continue as an annual commemoration and reminder of the help that is still needed. It is our hope that through the readings, the disaster at Chornobyl will become more than a five-minute remembrance on the radio.
